We are a non-profit organization supported solely by donations, grants and our fund-raising efforts.

## Assistance Programs

We have a spay/neuter program for owned pets as well as a community/feral cat spay/neuter program.

Our volunteers are at PETSMART every other Saturday from 11 am - 4 pm with our dogs and puppies that are available for adoption. ## Paws and Shop Thrift Store

We operate a thrift store to help fund our programs.

Paws and Shop is run by our volunteers, we have no paid staff, and is located at 2806 Putnam Avenue in Hurricane, WV. Our shop is filled with new and gently used items that can be purchased at very reasonable prices. Paws and Shop is open Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 10 am until 4 pm. We are always accepting donations (except clothing and electronics) and as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, any donations are tax deductible.



## Adoption Fees

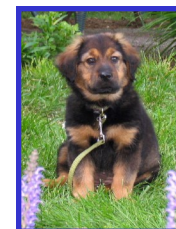
Our cat/kitten adoption fee is \$75 and includes:

- An adoring cat/kitten
- Spay/Neuter Surgery
- FVRCP Vaccinations
- De-worming
- Rabies Vaccination (Cats over 3 months only)
- Feline Leukemia Test
- Feline Aids Test
- Flea Control
- Microchip and registration



Our dog/puppy adoption fee is \$90 and includes:

- An adoring dog/puppy
- Spay/Neuter surgery
- DHLPP Vaccinations
- Flea Control
- Rabies Vaccination (dogs over 3 months only)
- Microchip and registration
- De-worming
- Heartworm Test and/or Heartworm Preventative (Dogs over 6 months only)
